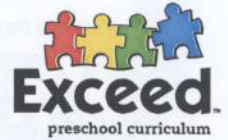


PARENT PARTICIPATION LETTER



Please read to your child as often as possible.

Dear Parents,

Welcome to **May Week 4** of **Exceed Preschool Curriculum** for three year olds. This week's theme is "Camping."

The **Language/Literacy Focus** will review all letters of the alphabet and introduce the rhyme or song, "The ABC Song." In the **Math/Science Focus**, children will review naming shapes (circle, square, triangle) and colors, count objects 1-5 and work with puzzles. **Music** activities will include dancing like sailboats and a "sharing" activity to music. In the **Art Focus**, children will work with templates, make a camping collage picture and cut with scissors.

This is the last week in the spring quarter of **Exceed Preschool Curriculum**. Your children have been introduced to all the letters of the alphabet. They have also worked with matching and matching sequence of patterns and counting objects 1-5. Children have also reviewed all the primary colors and "circles" "squares" and "triangles."

Suggestions to Enrich Classroom Activities

1. Bring your child's favorite book about camping. (Please write his/her name inside the front of the book.)
2. Make a copy of your child's favorite CD/cassette music for the classroom.
3. If available, bring old corks, plastic lids or any small objects that will float.
