As you think about your New Year's Resolutions, I hope you will consider a short term Bible Study as a part of your faith journey. Many of you are unable to participate in Sunday morning study for various reasons, and so I hope you will consider joining me for a study of the gospel of Mark beginning on January 3, 6:30 - 8:30 p.m.

This study will use the book by N.T. Wright called Mark: 20 Studies for Individuals and Groups. This little book is mostly a reflection going through the entire gospel of Mark, with many opportunities for meditation and thought. We will cover two chapters each week, which corresponds to roughly 1.5 chapters of Mark each week.

Each week I will be focusing my teaching upon a particular passage from that week's readings (which you will know about in advance). This passage will be the basis for the following Sunday sermon. The exciting thing about this is that our discussion on Tuesday will undoubtedly shape the sermon to be delivered on Sunday!

If there is enough interest, I will also hold the same study during the **daytime hours** for those who wish to attend during the day, most likely on a Thursday early afternoon.

Please let me know by **December 15 if you are planning to attend** so I may order a book for you.

If you have never done a Bible study before, this is a great way to "get your feet wet" and to experience the joy of learning more about God's Word and the experience of sharing it with others. . .

Hanging of the Greens—Sunday, December 4, 5:00 p.m.

Mark your calendars to attend this family fun event sponsored by our Eat, Love, Pray group. The whole church is invited to participate beginning at 5:00 p.m. with a short service and some carols. Immediately following the service we will decorate the entire church. After all the decorations are placed, we will have a meal together.



This is a great way to celebrate the season and have some fun. Also, make a note that on Sunday, January 1, we will take down the greens immediately following the 11:00 a.m. service.

Messiah

The sermons throughout the season will each focus on a portion of the texts from Handel's Messiah. These texts were compiled by Charles Jennens and given to G. F. Handel to write a musical work. Handel completed the three-act oratorio in approximately 24 days, although he revised it for many years before it became the version that we know and love today. It was first performed in Dublin, Ireland on April 13, 1742. The oratorio functions as a three-part extended meditation on the Messiah, with each of the three parts focusing on a different theological idea about the Messiah. The Messiah has become Handel's most beloved work and is nothing less than a masterpiece. On Sunday morning December 11 the Chancel Choir, Soloists and Orchestra will present the Christmas Portion of the Messiah for the 11:00 a.m. service. You will not want to miss this service.

The Stone

In 1271 Marco Polo stopped at a small church in Jerusalem and discovered a lamp that had been burning for 1200 years. The story of that lamp changed his life forever. We hope that you will come to worship and listen as the Praise on High Worship team tells this story in music, word and action. It might change your life too...

Silence in Worship:

Theological Reflection for the Pastor

It's wonderful to socialize when we come to worship on Sunday. It is one of the things I love about LHPC: the warm greetings, the genuine relationships and friendships, the deep connections. Having our coffee in the Narthex creates a wonderful space for "catching up" with each other. Every Sunday voices are abuzz in the Narthex up to the time of worship. Sometimes it's hard to move from lively social time into worship. Here's where silence comes in.

Silence draws us both inward and upward as we settle into the sanctuary worship space. Silence gives us a "breather" from the busyness of social time and the hectic pace of our week. Silence allows space for God, and space to hear the beautiful musical offerings prepared by our church musicians. This is true whether it be the organist, the choir, or the bell choir, or whether it is a more "rocking" offering of the praise band.

The first song in Praise on High, and the Prelude at the traditional service are both musical offerings of worship. Our musicians work hard to prepare these to lead in worship. When the music begins, worship begins, and we place ourselves deliberately into the presence of the Living God.

Take a breath before you walk through the sanctuary doors. Quiet yourself, and listen. You just might be surprised what you will hear. . .

What's Pastor Phyllis' Role?

I have already had lots of questions about our new Parish Associate, the Rev. Phyllis Speck. I hope this will help clarify her role.

Phyllis' position here is very part time (one day per week). She will receive an extremely modest (and limited) amount of business expense reimbursement for her work. She will not receive a salary or other compensation. Our agreement with Phyllis is that she will work eight hours a week on average. When you consider she will be here most Sunday mornings, the time she will have for pastoral care duties will probably be about five hours a week.

Her main role is to help support pastoral care at LHPC. I will continue to provide counseling, home and hospital visits, crisis intervention, and bereavement care for the congregation. Pastor Phyllis and I will work together to share some of that work when necessary, and she will be helping empower congregation members to provide pastoral care, too. She will be the pastor "on call" when I am travelling or not available. She may preach from time to time, especially in my absence.

Some have asked about her denominational affiliation, which is PC-USA. Our plan of Union indicates that if there are two permanently installed pastors, they must represent the two different denominations of which we are members (PC-USA and Cumberland). The Parish Associate position is not a called pastor. It is neither permanent nor installed, and this is why we are free to accept Phyllis' gracious service at LHPC. It is a similar situation to that which existed when both Pastors Bob and Robert Shelton were on staff (both being Cumberland members, one installed and the other not).

I hope you will introduce yourself to Phyllis and soon have the opportunity to get to know her! We are very blessed to have her serving here at LHPC.

Vision/Planning Task Force Update

The second phase of LHPC's Vision/Planning Process is successfully underway. Thank you to the almost 60 individuals who have volunteered to serve on the Task Forces, providing us a broad, diverse base of knowledge and input as we move forward. Both the Communications and the Community Outreach / Evangelism Task Forces have each met and are beginning to develop their goals for this year.

The Communications Task Force agreed upon a Strategic Statement to guide its efforts over the next year: The LHPC Communications Task Force will evaluate and revise, as necessary, communication strategies for 1) drawing new members to LHPC and 2) creating a sense of connection and knowledge about the church among current members.

The Community Outreach / Evangelism Task Force has started this phase by working to define LHPC's Community and what Outreach and Evange-

lism mean in terms of establishing goals for this year.

The Leadership Development, Congregational Participation, and Debt / Financial Resources / Stewardship Task Forces are finalizing the identification of individuals working with them on their Task Forces and will be scheduling their meetings in the near future. The Space Task Force will begin meeting after the first of the year.

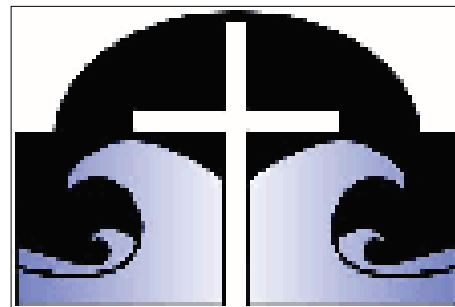
